- **HemCalm Suppositories** offer a practical option for internal hemorrhoids. This twice-daily application maintains contact between the affected area and healing agent for continued improvement through the day and night.
- **HemCalm Tablets** are taken orally and act systemically on both kinds of hemorrhoids. They have active ingredients that target some of the factors triggering the occurrence of hemorrhoids.

Astringents (calamine, zinc oxide, etc.)	Provokes coagulation of skin cells, forming a protective layer and decreasing itching and irritation.	Usually well tolerated.	Excessive use may cause local dryness and irritation.

Methylsulfonylmethane (MSM)	Decreases itching, bleeding, and irritation when used with hyaluronic acid and tea tree oil.	Safe when used short term (20 days).	Data related to long-term use are lacking.


